



CITIZEN'S BUDGET AND ANNUAL BUDGETS COMPARE



A Citizens Budget is a document that summarizes and explains basic budget information. It is a report to the people, presented in an accessible format using simple and clear language they can understand. It is a means to ensure the participation of the citizens in the budgeting process and serves as a tool to ensure that the budget is shared with the public transparently and that the people take part in the budgeting process.

Annual budget is a plan for projected Revenue and Expenditures over the course of a year. Annual budgets act as benchmarks against which the Government can measure progress and better manage monies.

Simply put, it is financial plan of Government's Income and Expenditure for a fiscal year. That is, 1st January to December 31st.


