ENVIRONMENTAL DEVELOPMENT LEVY (EDL)

Service:

Environmental Development Levy is the payment collected by spaces occupied by all Facilities.

Legal Basis:

- The power to collect Environmental Development Levy fee is enshrined in the Environmental Waste Control Regulation 2013 (B60) Section xix, Regulation 92.
 - The Environmental Sanitations and Waste Control Regulation 2013 page B33 Regulation 64 stipulated that every Company, Commercial, Facility, Corporate Body and Business Firm shall pay Environmental Development Charge within 3 weeks.

Timeline:

An average of 24 hour is required from point of assessment to getting your receipt

PAYMENT PROCEDURES

For clients within the State.

- Visit the Ministry's notice board for information on the prescribed fees to be paid.
- Proceed to any commercial bank within Oyo State.
- Pay the appropriate amount into the Oyo State Government Account with Revenue Codes **4020141** tagged "Environmental Development Levy.

- Obtain the electronic revenue receipt of the amount paid from the Bank.
- Produce two (2) photocopies of the revenue receipt.
- Proceed to Treasury Office (Room 22) of the Office of the Accountant General for confirmation of the electronic receipts.
 - Take the confirmed revenue receipt to Environmental Pollution and Monitoring unit for further processing.

2. For client intending to use online payments:

- Proceed to **payment.oyostatebir.com**
- Click on proceed to payment
- Select Oyo State Ministry of Environment and Natural Resources drop-down.
- Select a revenue type on the drop-down.
- Enter the amount to be paid, payment period and fill in your personal information
- Click on review entries
- Click on proceed to payment, you will be redirected to **myxpresspay** where you will make your payment
- Print out the electronic receipt generated; produce two (2) photocopies of the receipt.
- Proceed to Treasury Office (Room 22) of the Office of the Accountant General for confirmation of the electronic receipts.
- Take the confirmed revenue receipt to Environmental Pollution and Monitoring unit for further processing.
